NSI opens 10th HNK: HNK Utrecht Central Station

HOOFDORP, 15 October 2015 – NSI N.V. (“NSI”) officially opened its 10th HNK location yesterday. The mayor of Utrecht, Mr. Jan van Zanen, performed the opening ceremony. HNK stands for The New Office (‘Het Nieuwe Kantoor’). With this concept, NSI is anticipating the growing need for full service and flexible leasing solutions in the office market.

The HNK concept is being characterised by the ‘social heart’; the central space on the ground floor which is being equipped with over 100 working stations, sitting areas, long working tables and the HNK Café Soof. Furthermore, the meeting rooms and the managed offices (fully equipped offices) are located on the ground floor. ‘Tailored offices’ (leasing exactly the required space) are available on the upper floors.
