NSI signs 10-year rental agreement with Murata in Hoofddorp

Hoofddorp, 20 August 2013 – NSI N.V. (“NSI”) has signed a 10-year rental agreement with Murata Electronics Europe (Murata). Murata will rent around 1,800 m² of office space and accompanying parking spaces at Wegalaan 2-8 in Hoofddorp. Murata will move into the building, which is prominently located, on 1 January 2014. Before that date, the office spaces will be adapted to Murata’s requirements. The arrival of Murata means that most of the multi-tenant building is rented out.

About 275 m² office space on the ground floor and about 800 m² on the third floor are still available.

NSI has three buildings located next to each other in the De Beukenhorst area in Hoofddorp. NSI’s HNK Hoofddorp building, is situated diagonally opposite the offices that Murata will rent and offers flexible office and conference space. HNK Hoofddorp will open its doors in September 2013.

Cushman & Wakefield Amsterdam and DTZ Hoofddorp acted in cooperation in this transaction on behalf of NSI. Jones Lang LaSalle arranged the transaction on behalf of Murata Electronics Europe.
